Religion: We are now working through chapter 5 in religion. This chapter focuses on living in a community. Some of the vocabulary words we will focus on are Holy Trinity, morality, community, and common good.

Spelling: We will work on Unit 9 this week. It focuses on multisyllabic words with –ive, -ace, -age, and -ate.

Social Studies: Chapter 3 focuses on natural wonders and man-made wonders in our state. The vocabulary words to focus on this week are: natural wonders, human-made wonders, National Park Service, natural areas, history, restore, rebuilt, replica, heritage, and tourist attractions.
